## Nordby Center's

### 3rd ANNUAL 'LOVE OF THE GAME'

#### Saturday, February 12th

#### **Tournament Rules**

- 1) 18-minute halves with running clock, stopping only in the last MINUTE of 2<sup>nd</sup> half only and on all timeouts. If the score differential is 15 points or more, the clock will continue to run the last two minutes of the game.
- 2) If a team calls a timeout during a free throw, the clock will stop until the ball is touched by a player or inbounded by the opposite team (regular SDHSAA rules).
- 3) 3 time-outs per team per game (all timeouts are 30 SECONDS 1st HORN / 40 SECONDS 2ND HORN ROLL)
  - a. HUSTLE IN & HUSTLE OUT OF TIMEOUTS KEEP THE GAME & DAY MOVING!!
- 4) 2-minute half-time.
- No zone defenses allowed. (However, help-side/weak-side man-to-man defenses are allowed. Defenders must move with offensive player).
- 6) No full court presses allowed until the last MINUTE of the 2<sup>nd</sup> half only.
- 7) A full court press will not be allowed after a 15-point or more lead.
- 8) Intermediate 28.5 basketballs used. TEAMS NEED TO BRING THEIR OWN BALLS!!
- 9) Free-throw lines: Regulation FT line. Player may cross the line after release, however, may not crash in to rebound until after the ball contacts the rim. Players around the lane may leave on release. The shooter and players outside the free throw area may not crash until the ball hits the rim.
- 10) Technical fouls will result in two points and the ball back for the opposition.
- 11) Only one coach is allowed to stand during the game. All assistant coaches must remain seated.
- 12) All other SDHSAA rules will apply.
- 13) <u>Warm-up times:</u> may vary due to schedule constraints expect 3:00 minute warmups -- we will try to stay on, if not ahead of schedule. Schedule and game times will be rolling; meaning if we get ahead of schedule, we will continue to put 3:00 minutes up for warmups and continue to play. If we are **BEHIND** schedule, we will put 2:00 minute warmup up and continue to play.

**14)** If overtime is needed:

First OT: 1-minute with jump ball

Second OT: Sudden death with jump ball

- 15) Each team must supply a bookkeeper and the home team will be considered the official scorekeeper.
- 16) Rules to determine the winner of the tournament:

To determine place finish in Pool Play and championship round if needed:

- a) Head to Head
- b) Defensive Points Allowed
- c) Offensive Points Scored
- d) Coin flip
- 17) The Nordby Center for Recreation has **zero tolerance** for unsportsmanlike conduct.

  Anyone displaying any sort of unsportsmanlike conduct will be given a technical foul and escorted out of the building for the remainder of the tournament.
